Through collaboration with DISA, General Services Administration (GSA), and vendors, the DEOS Blanket Purchase Agreement (BPA) is a 10-year DOD preferred contracting vehicle for cloud technology enablement for the department. There are 13 Task Areas to cover the full breadth of cloud technology support necessary to engineer, migrate, deploy, and sustain customers.

The streamlined ordering process is simple, which includes close collaboration with DISA, General Services Administration (GSA) and vendors. Designed to be flexible to meet the ever-changing technologies, the BPA offers an extensive suite of offerings both on the unclassified and classified ecosystems with the requisite flexibility to allow for nearly any configuration or service a mission partner may require.

DISA deployed DOD365-Secret (DOD365-Sec), a Microsoft Productivity Software as a Service (SaaS) within a Department of Defense classified mission network. The DOD365-Sec tenant is the department's first classified cloud environment which brings industry-leading applications, intelligent cloud services, and world-class security to the warfighter.

DOD365-Sec

- Enables the department to improve interoperability and enhance cybersecurity across operational boundaries
- Delivers a standardized toolset enabling seamless collaboration efforts across combatant commands, military services, and defense agencies worldwide in a dependable, user-friendly environment

DOD365-Sec Features and Capabilities

DOD365-Sec provides a similar Microsoft 365 experience users are familiar with on the unclassified network. The classified cloud provides Mission Partners a unified environment to seamlessly collaborate and share classified material via Outlook, OneDrive, SharePoint, Office, Teams, etc.

- ✓ ISEC7 CLASSIFY is enabled for DISA personnel for Outlook on the Web and will roll out soon for Outlook Desktop
- ✓ ISEC7 CLASSIFY is ready for enablement for additional Mission Partners, upon confirmation of readiness
- Due to potential conflicts existing/legacy Classification and Marking Tools, rollout of ISEC7 CLASSIFY needs to be coordinated closely with Mission Partners; see the DISA Advisory Message to validate readiness on the DEOS Information Hub:
